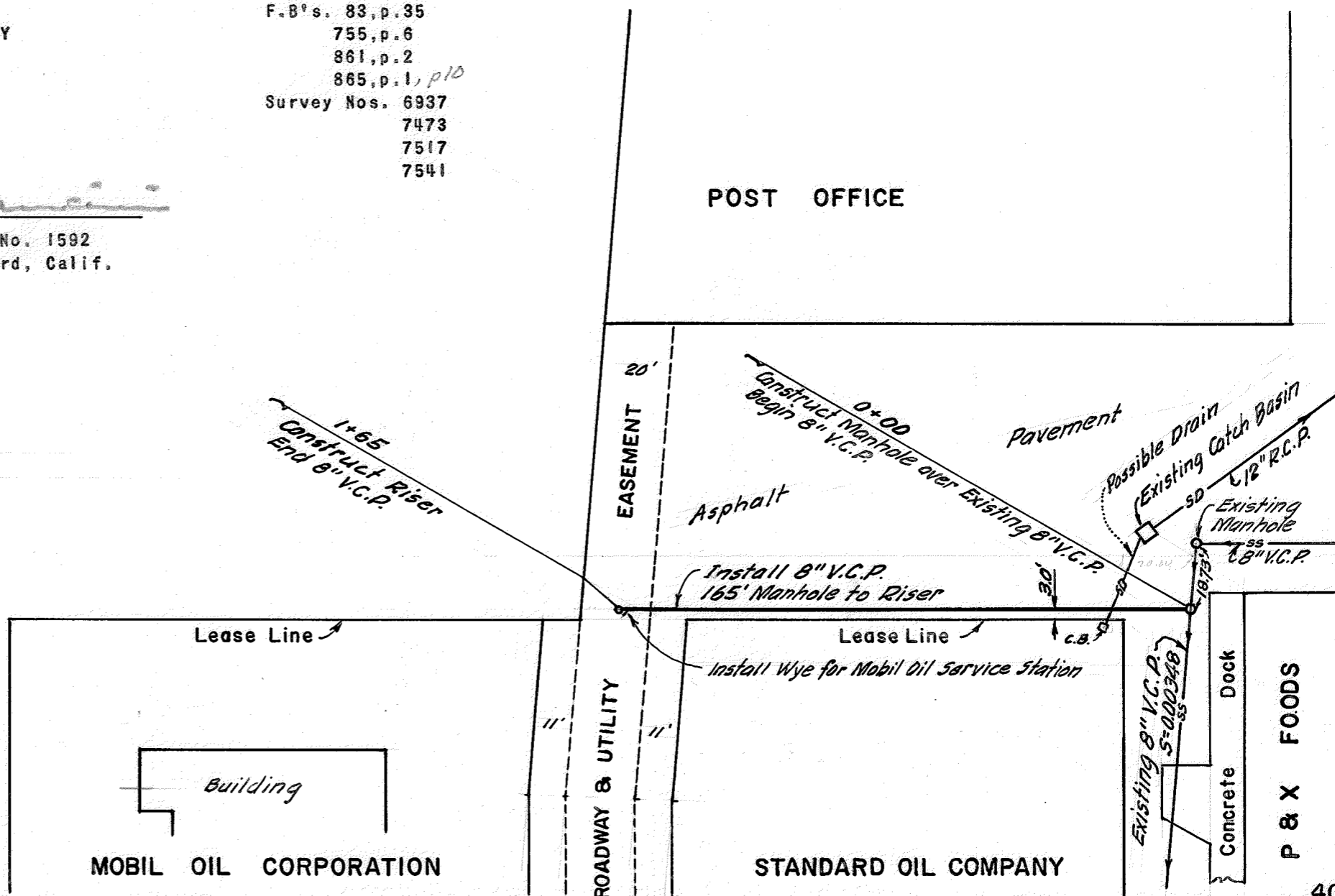
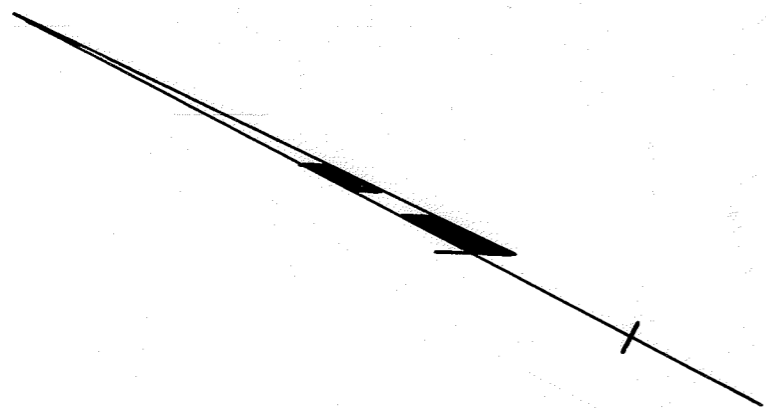

NOTES:

- Vitrified clay pipe shall be extra strength pipe, ASTM Designation: C200.
- Joints for vitrified clay pipe shall be of the mechanical compression joint type and shall conform to the latest requirements of ASTM Designation: C425.
- Manhole shall be precast concrete manhole, 4' in diameter.
- Manhole frame and cover shall be of the weight as used in public streets and shall meet the requirements of the Oro Loma Sanitary District.
- The riser shall conform to the requirements of the Oro Loma Sanitary District.
- All work shall be done in conformance with the requirements of the Oro Loma Sanitary District.
- Pavement replacement shall be 2" of asphalt concrete on 6" of Class 2 aggregate base.
